Notes to the Financial Statements

For the year ended 31 March 2025

Note 1 General

The Foundation of the International Society of Blood Transfusion (the Foundation) was established in 2006 with the objective to support research and education initiatives. In 2013, the Foundation was reconstituted with a new Board of Directors and a new focus to provide funding for education in transfusion-related fields especially in the developing world.

The Foundation is governed by a Board of Directors of five members who serve voluntarily. The Foundation has no employees.

The Foundation is registered as a charity (*Algemeen Nut Beoogde Instelling* or *ANBI*) in the Netherlands. The Foundation's primary source of funding is the annual net result of the International Society of Blood Transfusion.

Note 2 Accounting policies

The principal accounting policies applied in the preparation of these financial statements are set out below. Such policies have been applied consistently for all periods presented.

2.1 Basis of preparation

The Foundation's financial statements have been prepared in accordance with the historical cost method and are presented in euros.

2.2 Donations

Donations are recognised in the year they are received.

2.3 Applications funded

Applications funded are recognised in the year they are paid.

2.4 Operating expenses

Operating expenses are recognised in the period in which they are incurred.
