Introduction

The I TRY IT 2024 programme is an initiative of the ISBT Academy and is led by members of the Transfusion-Transmitted Infectious Diseases, Clinical Transfusion and Red Cell Immunohaematology Working Parties.

1. About the programme

I TRY IT is a two part programme:

- Part 1 Training in Study Design and Protocol Development
- Part 2 Training in Analysing Data and Manuscript Preparation

The two parts of the programme are offered in different years. The 2024 programme will focus on Part 2: Reporting and Publishing Scientific Research. The objective is to support young investigators in the process of converting data to results and results into manuscripts fit for publication.

2. Objectives

The 4 main objectives of the 2024 I TRY IT programme are to learn how to:

To **complete a research protocol** for a study designed to be conducted in your country or where your work.

- 1. Make the data analysis phase more efficient;
- 2. Streamline the writing process by developing results from tables/figures;
- 3. Write each section of a manuscript
- 4. Learn how to provide and receive **constructive criticism of scientific** writing.

The most challenging part of publishing a manuscript is knowing

where to start. A key component for successful publication is a high-quality, complete dataset – an essential requirement for this program. Through this manuscript-writing course, you will be mentored through the process of converting your data to a scientific manuscript.

There are many 'bright ideas' or research discoveries in the field of transfusion medicine that are waiting for young investigators.

So jump in, say "I TRY IT", and send us your applications for I TRY IT 2024 programme.

3. Methods

Online live lectures: Participants and instructors are located all over the world. It is required for you to participate in the live lectures online. Attending the live lectures is the most certain way for you to learn the content and be able to ask questions to improve your depth of knowledge. We will be using Zoom™ for course lectures. To participate, you will be invited to each online lecture and then will have to join the lecture via the URL provided in each invitation.

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Lecture recordings will be posted on ISBT Education after the session is completed. Each participant will have a specific login and password to access the content. This will enable you to access the content at times that works best for you.

Homeworks assigned will focus on writing the sections of a man-

uscript. As part of the programme you will write a manuscript that can be submitted for publication.

You will also be involved in reviewing draft manuscripts written by your peer colleges to experience the peer-review process as a reviewer and reviewee.

Based on your performance in the programme, and completion of your assigned homework before the congress, you will be sponsored to attend the **ISBT Barcelona in June 2024**. Three face-to-face sessions will be conducted during the congress. In addition, depending on the topic of your research you are expected to attend the Transfusion-Transmitted Infectious Diseases, Clinical Transfusion or Red Cell Immunohaematology Working Party meetings during the congress.

4. Applicants and application

Submit your application below before February 17, 2024

- ISBT membership is a requirement for joining this programme
- Preference will be given to participants from LMIC and those who completed Part 1 of the I TRY IT programme.

SUBMIT YOUR APPLICATION

To apply, please provide the following:

- 1. A current curriculum vitae (CV) or resume (please list any scientific publications)
- 2. A letter of interest with the following:
 - A short summary of the transfusion medicine related research you wish to publish. This must not exceed 500 words and should written in scientific

- abstract format (Background, Aims, Methods, Results, and Summary/Conclusions.
- Confirmation of the availability of a quality-checked dataset with at least initial data analysis completed.
- You will be asked to share the dataset and initial analysis with your mentor, unavailability of such dataset may result in your removal from the programme.
- A initial summary table of the main data analysis from your study. Kindly note that these data will not be used other than as part of evaluation of eligibility of entering the program. If you have not yet completed data analysis you must provide a shell table of the content that you expect will be the main results table to contain.
- Confirmation that you have permission to publish the data as first author.



5. Expenses Covered

Three interactive sessions including course lectures will be given face to face at the 38th international congress of the **ISBT in Barcelona**, **Spain in June 23 – 27**, **2024** (dates and times to be announced and may include I TRY IT meetings the day before or after the congress.)

Registration for this ISBT Congress is provided for the participants. Reasonable travel and accommodation expenses to attend this ISBT Congress will also be covered.

ISBT Central Office will work with you to arrange international travel. You are responsible for securing any required travel documents such as passports or visas. ISBT will assist you by providing letters of invitation, but you will have to apply and pay applicable fees yourself.
